### Nominating Committee Report, March 2017

This report contains the names (in italics) of those Friends recommended by the Nominating Committee to be approved at the Section Meeting in March 2017. Terms of service begin May 1, 2017.

An essential priority of the Nominating Committee is to provide balanced representation on committees, such as: by region, by gender, and by the "branch" of Quaker experience. Each name on this report is followed by the yearly meeting to which the representative belongs. (Regional coordinators are indicated by their region instead of their yearly meeting.) For more information about yearly meetings and their assignment to FWCC Regions, consult the last page of this report.

Names are listed in three columns based on the date on which the representative's committee assignment ends. Committee members are normally given three-year assignments that end at the conclusion of a Section Meeting. In most cases, members may only serve two consecutive terms on any one committee. Committee members serving their second term are indicated by a superscript "2" next to their name. Members without this designation are in their first term of service.

Those Friends who are assigned to committees and are not currently appointed representatives from their yearly meetings are considered co-opted representatives. Co-opted representatives at the time of this report are marked with a "c" by their yearly meeting. Note that committee assignments are not necessarily congruent with the terms to which representatives are named by their yearly meetings. Thus representatives' co-option status may change throughout the year. Committee members are urged to continue attending the Section Meetings to complete their service with their committee if at all possible. This permits continuity of committee activity.

## FWCC activities are carried out by:

- 1. Committees to carry out functions as specified in the by-laws.
- **2. Program Groups** to work on on-going "mission driven activities," i.e. programs.
- 3. Working Groups would work together on a defined task with a time-limited charge.
- 4. **Resource Groups** consisting of people who might or might not meet together. Individuals would serve limited, but specific roles, to advance a mission driven activity, to solve a problem or to provide specific skill sets and services. They might be called upon to serve in consultative roles to the Executive Secretary, other staff, or the Executive Committee, on an as-needed basis.
