A variety of proposals relating to Christian mysticism are given consideration by the Grants Committee. Recently funded projects have included grants for scholars doing original research work on Therese of Lisieux and Douglas Steere; a grant for presenting materials on traditions of prayer and contemplation over the internet; and funding for a retreat on "Silence, Contemplation and Scripture" sponsored by a residential retreat center.

## Applications

Proposals should be no more than two typed pages and include the following: a full description of the project, including an indication of how the project relates to the study and/or practice of Christian mysticism; the specific amount of money requested; the way the grant will be spent; an indication of any other resources expected to be called upon; and plans for communicating the results of the project to others.
