How to make gifts of stock or other securities

The Friends World Committee accepts gifts of shares of stock or other securities via the Friends Fiduciary Corporation. To make a gift, please follow these steps:

1. Contact the Friends World Committee and provide us with:

Company name and CUSIP number of the stock and number of shares
Date transfer is expected to be completed
Name of your broker and contact person with telephone number

2. Supply the following information to your broker:

The shares should be delivered via DTC wire #2803 to U. S. Bank N.A.,
Institutional Number 12278, for deposit into Account # 10996-01-J,
Consolidated Fund Participant Income Account.
